

## Bible Reading Memory Plan—NASB – 2008

This plan is designed to be used in conjunction with the Bible Reading Plan. Every week a verse(s) is selected from assigned reading. The verses will appear each week in the bulletin and can be accessed on the church website. Small groups going through the Bible Reading Plan may also recite them weekly.

### Week of 1/1-1/6

**Genesis 3:15** <sup>15</sup> *And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel."*

### Week of 1/7-13

**Matthew 5:17-18** <sup>17</sup> *"Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill. <sup>18</sup> "For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass from the Law until all is accomplished.*

### Week of 1/14-20

**Acts 10:42-43** <sup>42</sup> *"And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly to testify that this is the One who has been appointed by God as Judge of the living and the dead. <sup>43</sup> "Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins."*

### Week of 1/21-27

**Psalms 23:1-3** <sup>NAU</sup> **Psalm 23:1** *A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want. <sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters. <sup>3</sup> He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.*

### Week of 1/28-2/3

**Matthew 11:28-30** <sup>28</sup> *"Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. <sup>30</sup> "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."*

### Week of 2/4-10

**Exodus 20:1-3** <sup>NAU</sup> **Exodus 20:1** *Then God spoke all these words, saying, <sup>2</sup> "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. <sup>3</sup> "You shall have no other gods before Me.*

### Week of 2/11-17

<sup>NAU</sup> **Psalm 34:8** *O taste and see that the LORD is good; How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!*

### Week of 2/18-24

<sup>NAU</sup> **Acts 28:23** *When they had set a day for Paul, they came to him at his lodging in large numbers; and he was explaining to them by solemnly testifying about the kingdom of God and trying to persuade them concerning Jesus, from both the Law of Moses and from the Prophets, from morning until evening.*

**Week of 2/24-3/2**

**Romans 1:16-17** <sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "BUT THE RIGHTEOUS man SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."

**Week of 3/3-9**

**Psalms 51:9-10** <sup>9</sup> Hide Your face from my sins And blot out all my iniquities. <sup>10</sup> Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

**Week of 3/10-16**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Numbers 23:19** "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?"

**Week of 3/17-23**

**Romans 11:33 - 12:1** <sup>33</sup> Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! <sup>34</sup> For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, OR WHO BECAME HIS COUNSELOR? <sup>35</sup> Or WHO HAS FIRST GIVEN TO HIM THAT IT MIGHT BE PAID BACK TO HIM AGAIN? <sup>36</sup> For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen.

**Week of 3/24-4/6**

**Matthew 28:18-20** <sup>18</sup> And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

**Week of 4/7-13**

**Joshua 24:14-15** <sup>14</sup> "Now, therefore, fear the LORD and serve Him in sincerity and truth; and put away the gods which your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD. <sup>15</sup> "If it is disagreeable in your sight to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves today whom you will serve: whether the gods which your fathers served which were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living; but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

**Week of 4/14-20**

**Psalms 90:1-2** <sup>NAU</sup> A Prayer of Moses, the man of God. Lord, You have been our dwelling place in all generations. <sup>2</sup> Before the mountains were born Or You gave birth to the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.

**Week of 4/21-27**

<sup>NAU</sup> **1 Corinthians 15:3** For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

**Week of 4/28-5/4**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Mark 10:45** "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

**Week of 5/5-11**

<sup>NAU</sup> **2 Corinthians 5:6** *Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord--<sup>7</sup> for we walk by faith, not by sight--<sup>8</sup> we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.*

**Week of 5/12-18**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Psalms 111:1** *Praise the LORD! I will give thanks to the LORD with all my heart, In the company of the upright and in the assembly.<sup>2</sup> Great are the works of the LORD; They are studied by all who delight in them.*

**Week of 5/19-25**

<sup>NAU</sup> **2 Samuel 22:29** *"For You are my lamp, O LORD; And the LORD illumines my darkness.*

**Week of 5/26-6/1**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Ephesians 1:3** *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,<sup>4</sup> just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him.*

**Week of 6/2-8**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Psalms 119:11** *Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against You.*

**Week of 6/9-15**

<sup>NAU</sup> **1 Kings 18:38** *Then the fire of the LORD fell and consumed the burnt offering and the wood and the stones and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.<sup>39</sup> When all the people saw it, they fell on their faces; and they said, "The LORD, He is God; the LORD, He is God."*

**Week of 6/16-22**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Luke 6:27** *"But I say to you who hear, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you,<sup>28</sup> bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.*

**Week of 6/23-30**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Philippians 4:4** *Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice!<sup>5</sup> Let your gentle spirit be known to all men. The Lord is near.<sup>6</sup> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.*

**Week of 6/30-7/6**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Colossians 1:13** *For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,<sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.*

**Week of 7/7-13**

<sup>NAU</sup> **1 Chronicles 16:10** *Glory in His holy name; Let the heart of those who seek the LORD be glad.<sup>11</sup> Seek the LORD and His strength; Seek His face continually.*

**Week of 7/14-20**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Psalm 139:17** *How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How vast is the sum of them!<sup>18</sup> If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand. When I awake, I am still with You.*

**Week of 7/21-27**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Luke 12:15** *Then He said to them, "Beware, and be on your guard against every form of greed; for not even when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions."*

**Week of 7/28-8/3**

<sup>NAU</sup> **1 Timothy 1:5** *But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.*

**Week of 8/4-10**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Proverbs 6:16** *There are six things which the LORD hates, Yes, seven which are an abomination to Him:<sup>17</sup> Haughty eyes, a lying tongue, And hands that shed innocent blood,<sup>18</sup> A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that run rapidly to evil,*

**Week of 8/11-17**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Nehemiah 8:10** *Then he said to them, "Go, eat of the fat, drink of the sweet, and send portions to him who has nothing prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."*

**Week of 8/18-24**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Titus 3:4** *But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared,<sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,*

**Week of 8/25-9/7**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Proverbs 31:30** *Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.*

**Week of 9/8-14**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Luke 22:26** *"But it is not this way with you, but the one who is the greatest among you must become like the youngest, and the leader like the servant.*

**Week of 9/15-21**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Isaiah 40:1** *"Comfort, O comfort My people," says your God.<sup>2</sup> "Speak kindly to Jerusalem; And call out to her, that her warfare has ended, That her iniquity*

*has been removed, That she has received of the LORD'S hand Double for all her sins."*

**Week of 9/22-28**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Hebrews 12:28** *Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe; <sup>29</sup> for our God is a consuming fire.*

**Week of 9/29-10/5**

<sup>NAU</sup> **John 1:1** *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God.*

**Week of 10/6-12**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Jeremiah 17:7** *"Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD And whose trust is the LORD. <sup>8</sup> "For he will be like a tree planted by the water, That extends its roots by a stream And will not fear when the heat comes; But its leaves will be green, And it will not be anxious in a year of drought Nor cease to yield fruit.*

**Week of 10/13-19**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Ecclesiastes 12:13** *The conclusion, when all has been heard, is: fear God and keep His commandments, because this applies to every person.*

**Week of 10/20-26**

<sup>NAU</sup> **1 Peter 4:11** *Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves is to do so as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. <sup>12</sup> Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you;*

**Week of 10/27-11/2**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Job 2:10** *But he said to her, "You speak as one of the foolish women speaks. Shall we indeed accept good from God and not accept adversity?" In all this Job did not sin with his lips.*

**Week of 11/3-9**

<sup>NAU</sup> **John 8:31** *So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; <sup>32</sup> and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."*

**Week of 11/10-16**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Ezekiel 37:27** *"My dwelling place also will be with them; and I will be their God, and they will be My people.*

**Week of 11/17-23**

<sup>NAU</sup> **1 John 5:14** *This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.<sup>15</sup> And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.*

**Week of 11/24-30**

<sup>NAU</sup> **John 13:34** *"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another."<sup>35</sup> "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."*

**Week of 12/1-7**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Hosea 3:5** *Afterward the sons of Israel will return and seek the LORD their God and David their king; and they will come trembling to the LORD and to His goodness in the last days.*

**Week of 12/8-14**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Revelation 5:9** *And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.*

**Week of 12/15-21**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Job 42:2** *"I know that You can do all things, And that no purpose of Yours can be thwarted.*

**Week of 12/22-28**

<sup>NAU</sup> **Malachi 4:2** *"But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall.*
