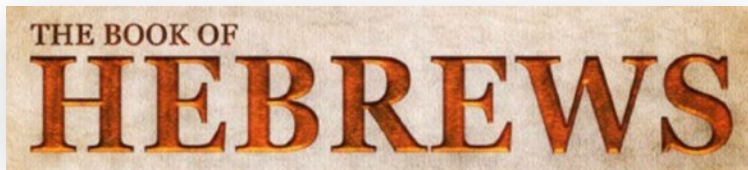
Senior Saints Lunch
