Our March Missionaries of the Month are **R and his wife R** who serve with MTW. They work stateside to train and equip people to go to sensitive fields overseas. The current 3-month long internship started in late February, with 7 adults—all who plan to work in sensitive mission fields after graduating. Pray for the interns to be engaged and clear minded as they study and prepare. Pray for wisdom for R & R as they teach and train in the coming months. Please pray for all those who are in the midst of war and rumors of war. Pray for the safety of the Christians in those regions and for the Gospel to spread in fertile soil.

MTW—Pray also for **J&B** who work in a sensitive field. They have decided to stay where they are (rather than return to the US) through the storms and gales of war in the area.
