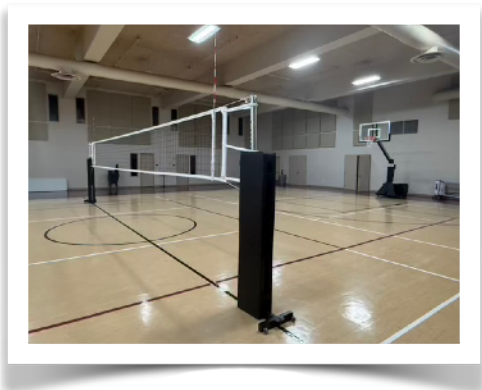
Southwest Reformed Youth Camp
